## Ronald McDonald Care Mobile Program Summary- 2020 Statistics

28 medical visits with 28 children on the Care Mobile during 2020. Since the program began in 2003, we have had 12,318 visits with 9,219 children.

Over \$8,292 of free care was provided by the Care Mobile in 2020 by the Nurse Practitioner. Since 2003, over \$2,345,485 in free care has been provided.

The majority of children seen on the Care Mobile have Medicaid or All Kids (68%), but a large number remain uninsured (approximately 30%). There is still a small population of children that have medical but no dental insurance, or unknown status.

- 43% Female, 57% Male
  
- 35 immunizations were given, including 6 meningitis vaccines, 6 Tdap vaccines, and 9 HPV vaccines. 28 medical visits were provided, and 7 children were seen repeatedly for an obesity diagnosis.
  
- Since the start of the program in 2003, we have been able to document at least 124 avoided emergency room visits due to care given on the Care Mobile.

\*The Care Mobile and staff were furloughed from the end of March until September due to the Covid-19 pandemic. The remainder of 2020 was spent readying the Care Mobile to provide safe and responsible operations in light of the risks of Covid-19 in the beginning of 2021, including deep cleaning, replacing a leaking gas tank, and preparing for both rooms to be able to be used fully as medical rooms.

*Because of these updates and precautions, the Care Mobile resumed services in 2021.*
