Time is precious when your child is critically ill. For some families, the ability to navigate a challenging medical journey means they have the strength and wisdom to comfort others going through similar situations. Whether they cross paths during a stay or find each other due to a common medical condition. these connections can be life-changing.

Sarah and her husband, Denzel, spent 208 days at RMHC-Madison while their 18month-old son was on a transplant list. They returned home this summer with a healthy toddler in tow.

During their stay, they met a family on a hospital elevator going through a nearly identical procedure. The mothers - Sarah and Isabella - started meeting for lunch; their shared experience preparing each other for the weeks ahead. When a match was discovered for Isabella's daughter, Sarah made the trip back to Madison to be by her side for surgery, and then again upon their discharge from the hospital.



"Throughout our journey, we formed the friendship of a lifetime. At any time of day if I need someone to talk to, she will be there," said Sarah. Isabella wholeheartedly agrees.
